

WHAT WE DO AND THE DIFFERENCE WE MAKE



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

We help pay for rent and household bills or provide gift cards to purchase gas and groceries, and we help cancer patients focus on their treatment instead of worrying about daily household stressors.



PATIENT EDUCATION

We provide free patient education and support programs that enrich the cancer journey for patients and caregivers. Our Foundation sponsors virtual and in-person workshops covering topics such as breast cancer, cancer and wellness and utilizing writing as a therapeutic tool.



OTHER RESOURCES

We distribute items such as blankets, port pillows, books for children about cancer, and patient care bags (with items such as socks, lotion, journals, etc.) for local cancer patients.

“I was taken out of work very unexpectedly and could not return until months later. During that time my family had no income. My family ended up running out of food and toilet paper and shampoo. *With the gift cards I was able to have food and household items.* We all truly appreciate all the help we have received.”





MECHANICVILLE STILLWATER BREAST CANCER WALK

Every October, the Mechanicville Stillwater Breast Cancer Walk, an all-volunteer event, aims to raise awareness and funds in memory of Jessica Mitchell. The event features a community walk alongside craft vendors, raffle baskets, food trucks, fireworks, and more. Leading up to the walk, the committee mobilizes and inspires the entire community through various activities, including fundraisers at high school soccer games, yard decorations with flocks of flamingoes, and displaying sponsor stickers in local business windows. The culmination is a pink takeover of Tallmadge Park, meticulously planned by a dedicated group of volunteers who work late nights from their kitchen tables. Since 2010, the Walk has donated over \$170,000 to the NYOH Community Cancer Foundation and supported the American Cancer Society and Saratoga Hospital.
