NYOH COMMUNITY CANCER FOUNDATION LAUNCHES COLORECTAL CANCER CHECK CHALLENGE TO RAISE AWARENESS AND FUNDS FOR LOCAL CANCER PATIENTS

The campaign was developed by Keri Alonzo, a Stage 3 Sigmoid Colon Cancer survivor and Foundation Program Coordinator of NYOH Community Cancer Foundation. Keri's personal journey fuels her dedication to spreading awareness and ensuring that every patient has access to the resources they need.

"As a survivor, I know firsthand how critical early detection is—it truly saves lives," said Alonzo. "The Colorectal Cancer Check Challenge is not just about raising funds but about starting conversations, breaking down stigmas, and empowering our community to take preventive steps."

The Colorectal Check Challenge Celebration will take place on Sunday, March 30, from 12 to 3 p.m. at Carson's Woodside Tavern in Malta. Guests can look forward to food, live music, and a vibrant community atmosphere. Tickets are priced at \$20 for presale and \$30 at the door.
